Situation Analysis

The entire country has become as standstill by the situation created due to COVID-19. The situation in Jharkhand is also more or less similar. Everything stopped during pandemic, many people have lost their jobs, whether they were rich or poor and sat idle at their homes. The condition of the workers became even more pathetic in mica mine area of Koderma, which did not have able to access government facilities. Especially those laborers of forest area who are living in remote forests, neither the government has reached to them nor they could reach the government. However, so many packages for relief have been declared by the state as well as central government.

Samarpan's responsibilities during lockdown:

In this crisis, responsibilities of Samarpan have increased manyfolds. Samarpan accepted the challenge and tried to slowdown the problems of vulnerable people with coordination of local administration and pancahyats.

Following initiatives had been taken by Samarpan .

- ❖ Identification of most vulnerable families.
- ❖ Arrangement and distribution of relief materials among 2100 families regularly.
- ❖ Donated Rs. 1 Lac in the Food bank of District administration.
- ❖ Awareness against COVID-19.
- ❖ Socio-psycho support.
- ❖ Protect children to go in mica-mines.
- ❖ Identification of helpless old age persons, orphans and physically challenged, who having no support:
- ❖ Documentation & Advocacy.
- ❖ Orientation of staff by virtual training
- ❖ Coordination with local administration for relief.
- ❖ Children who were wandering, begging and other needy were added to the DIDI Kitchen Garden.
- ❖ List of migrated labour were Collected and provided to the District Administration who could not come back home.
- ❖ Prepared phone directory to keep in contact with community.

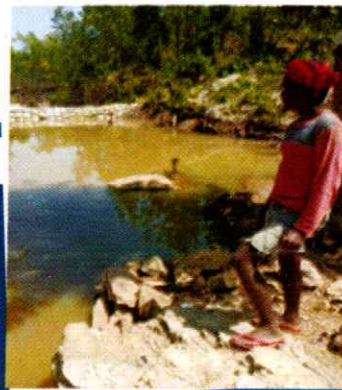


Samarpan's responsibilities after lockdown :

- ❖ To provide Socio-psycho support to the community.
- ❖ Keep children engage with education through worksheet and other means.
- ❖ To provide hand holding support for livelihood.
- ❖ Reduce domestic violence through counselling by legal & mental support.
- ❖ Regular support for survival of helpless old age, orphans and physically challenged.
- ❖ Link migrated labors with MNREGA
- ❖ Engage students in continuous study
- ❖ Aware community to save environment & water conservation.
- ❖ Distribution of study materials among the needy children
- ❖ Children are engaged in kitchen gardening, awareness, wall painting etc.
- ❖ Providing food materials to children from age 6 months to 3 years in each months enrolled in creches running with the support of **Samarpan**.
- ❖ Providing ration to 2100 old, physically challenged, widows and orphans.

Future Plan

- ❖ To Engage with small business for alternate livelihood.
- ❖ To support with livestock.
- ❖ Engage all children with continue education and protect them from mica mines.
- ❖ Support through sewing machine for additional earning.
- ❖ Promote agriculture through organic cultivation.
- ❖ Add maximum students with DIGISATH.
- ❖ Provide socio-psycho support among the community to reduce child marriage domestic violence and protect trafficking.
- ❖ Save forest and promote for herbal product.
- ❖ To provide regular dry ration and medical support to the vulunerable people.
- ❖ Will distribute blankets, cloths & mosquito nets in winter.
